Quilt Show Rules

Entries and Fees:

You may enter up to 5 quilts in the show:

- SRVQG members: \$5.00 for the first quilt and \$2.00 each, for subsequent quilts.
- Non-members: \$7.00 and \$3.00.
- Youth (under 18): \$1 per quilt.
- Fees are non-refundable.

Entry Form Deadline: January 31, 2017

- Entry forms including fees, must be received by the deadline and will be accepted until we have 150 entries. Additional entries will be accepted on a space-available basis.

Categories:

- Enter each quilt in one category only. More than one entry can be in the same category.
- SRVQG reserves the right to change the category selected and/or to combine categories.

Large Quilts have a perimeter of 300" or more;

Small Quilts have a perimeter less than 300";

2-Person Quilts are made by two people; typically, the person who made the top and the person who quilted it;

Group Quilts are created by at least 3 people and include, but not limited to Round Robins, Block Exchanges, etc.;

Art Quilts are of original design and execution;

Other are quilts that don't fit any of the above categories such as whole cloth, Yo-Yo quilts, etc.

Judging: Check the box on the entry form if your quilt is to be judged. The entry fee is the same either way. A panel of qualified judges will conduct all judging.

Ineligible Quilts:

- Quilts shown in previous SRVQG shows;
- Framed quilts;
- Tied or tricot quilts.

Quilt Delivery Deadline: March 20, 2017

Quilts will be accepted at the Jack Hamilton Bldg. located behind the Co. Extension Office on the Bonn. Co. Fair grounds - corner of Rollandet St. and Rogers St. between 10 AM and 2 PM. Make alternative arrangements with Margo Fisher, if necessary.

Mailed Entries Deadline: March 17, 2017

Shipped items must **arrive** at Margo Fisher's address (see "Entries and Fees") by Mar. 17, 2017, and will be returned after the show by the same courier, unless otherwise specified. Ship quilts in a **reusable** container. Enclose a RETURN ADDRESS LABEL, PREPAYMENT OF RETURN SHIPPING, AND INSURANCE COSTS. SRVQG assumes no responsibility for damages or loss incurred during shipping.

Quilt Returns: March 25, 2017

- Pick up is at the show facility between 6 and 7 PM. Be prepared to show a picture ID.
- Quilts **MUST** stay hung to the end of the show.

CHECK LIST: Be sure that....

1. Quilt is **clean** and in excellent condition;
2. Each entry has its own, signed form;
3. All quilts **MUST** have a minimum 2" (temporary) sleeve at the top. Additionally, sleeves for large quilts MUST have a break in the middle of the sleeve to accommodate a center support hook we use to hang them.
4. Attach a fabric label (temporary, but secure) to cover your label on the back of your quilt. Write your name and phone number.
