This month Alicia Williams will teach us about fabric weaving. Tools will be available for purchase

Community Support/Charity Program

I am in the process of inventorying what the Guild has for the program. So far we have:

1) Have 7 quilts with backs and batting that are ready for quilting. They are a range of sizes from 54 x 62 to 78 x 98.

2) Have 60 quilt tops that need backing fabric and batting

3) After the Holidays, I plan to schedule a fabric/batting cutting day - to get quilt tops ready for quilting.

4) Quilts will need to be trimmed and bound after quilting.

We need people willing to quilt the quilts that are ready. I've had three people volunteer to help with binding. Two people have volunteered to do long arm quilting after the holidays. We could use a few more – there are a lot of quilts.

We were able to donate 21 finished quilts to the Ronald McDonald Family Room at EIRMC this month. They were extremely happy to receive the quilts.
