An art quilt exhibit at The Carr Gallery inside the Willard Arts Center in Idaho Falls, ID, January 20 through March 12th.

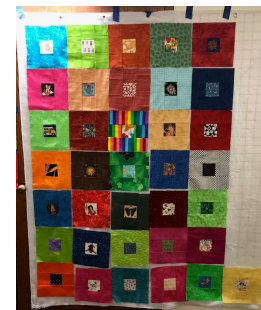

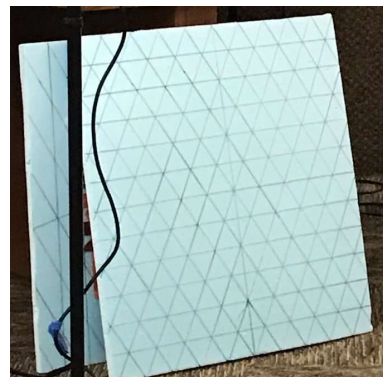
Julie introduce our speaker Alicia Williams.

“Fabric Weaving”

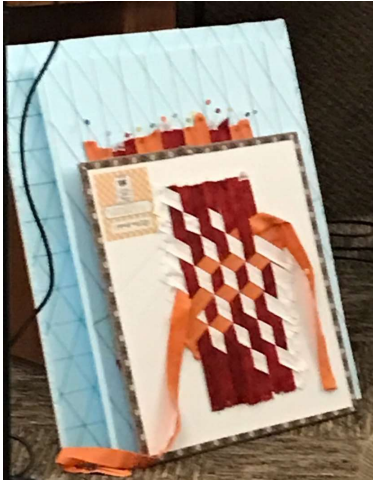

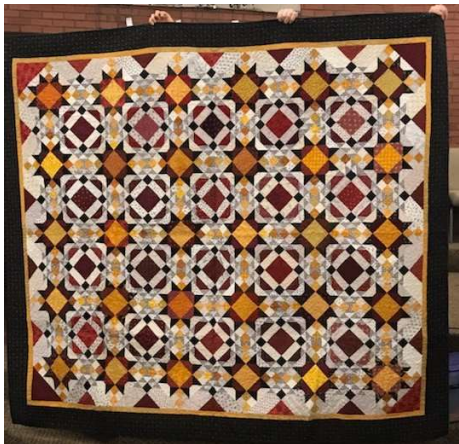

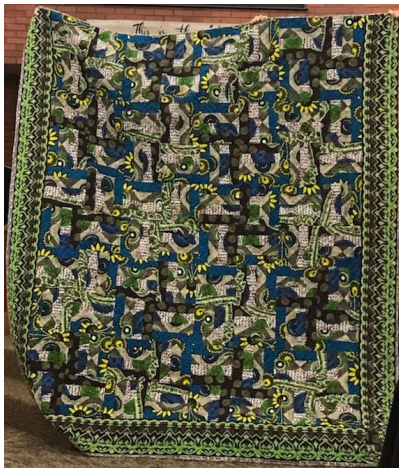
