She showed a technique for "Hearts and Gizzards"

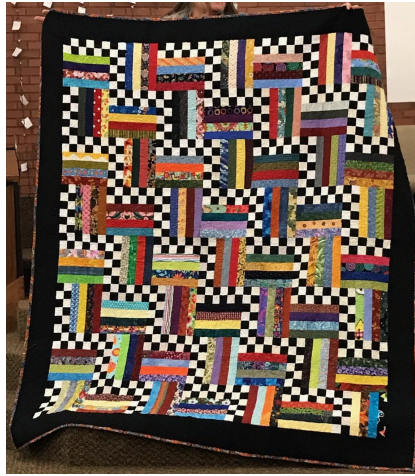
Uses a "Layer Cake"
