# Tips to Streamline Your Quilting by Karen Price

Karen always has several quilts started

Tips Karen uses in her quilting:

- 1. Find time to quilt (set a time that works for you)
- 2. Have a dedicated space
- 3. Keep space organized
- 4. Have leader fabric ready helps when starting a seam so the sewing machine does not get jammed up
- 5. Note Pad write down what needs to be done on the quilt etc.
- 6. Storage
  - a. Uses berry boxes from Sam's; keeps fabric, pattern and notes together
  - b. Food Containers some are re-usable and good for a project
  - c. Paper bowls and plates some plates are the perfect size for a block and you can stack them on top of each other
- 7. Organize your fabric
- 8. Make a flannel board make it a size that works for your projects
- 9. Have a design board
- 10. When winding bobbins do several at the same time
- 11. Don't forget to label your projects
- 12. Document the quilt and put in a binder with a picture of the finished quilt.
- 13. Blocks she has certain blocks that she likes to make. She will cut fabric for those blocks and store them together.

Hopefully there is a tip you can use to help streamline your quilting.
