The Village - A Foster Care Closet is a non-profit entity run by the Idaho Foster and Adoptive Parent Association. When a child comes into foster care, the Village immediately gives them a suitcase, a quilt or blanket, and a comfort toy. The Village received 21 of our quilts to share with their youth. They give out baby sizes up to twin sizes. They have difficulty getting quilts for teens, especially boys. They are currently are in need of the larger (twin) size quilts.

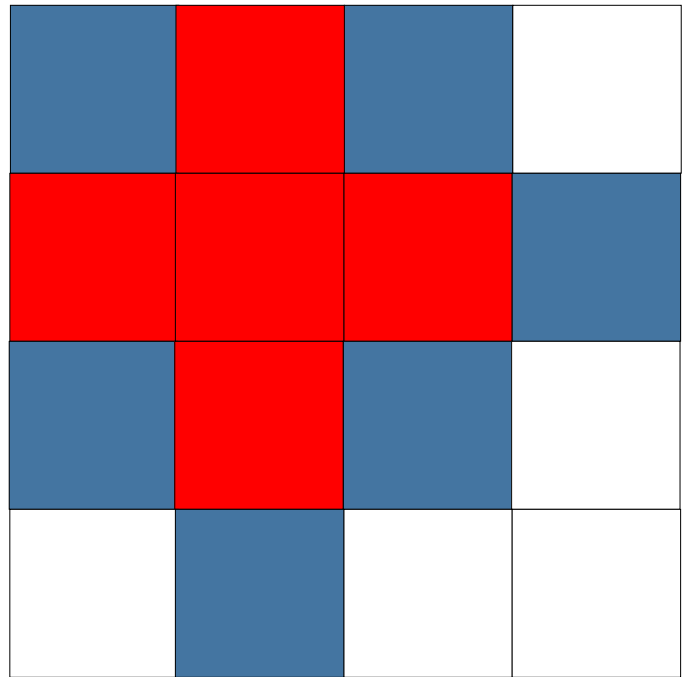
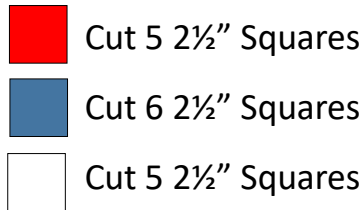
- ◆ Studio 180 Design split rectangle ruler. Please considering supporting your LQS.
- ◆ 2 yards print A for stars and inner border
- ◆ 2 yards print B for stars and binding
- ◆ 3 yards lighter contrasting print for blocks and setting triangles
- ◆ 1 1/2 yards darker contrasting print for outer border
- ◆ Sewing Machine
- ◆ Basic sewing supplies
- ◆ Small cutting mat and rotary cutter

The dimensions, if making the quilt, are 67" by 84". If anyone doesn't want to make the whole quilt, they can just bring some fat quarters which will be adequate to learn the technique.

Quilts of Valor Challenge Block



Sew squares together into rows.

Sew rows into blocks

Please use red, white, and blue fabrics appropriate for adults. Use NO sparkly fabrics or juvenile prints.

These blocks are easy to make. Sew your hearts out for our veterans. They have sacrificed greatly for us.

From 1 fat quarter cut into 2½" squares you will be able to make 56 2½" squares.
From 1 red, 1 blue and 1 white fat quarter you will be able to make 9 of the above blocks.

Bring your blocks to our guild meeting and give them to Karen Price. You will receive 1 ticket for each block to enter into a raffle to win a layer cake.
