I want to thank the board for all their hard work. You have all made my job easier.


Please consider stepping up and serving the Guild.

July Education will be presented by Diane Cresap. She will be teaching us about visible mending history and techniques.


The Annual Picnic will be August 18th!

I am excited to report that we purchased two bolts of 108" fabric for backings for Community Support Quilts - one is mottled beige tones and the other is blue tones. I will be cutting backs for all the quilt tops that have been donated in the next couple of months.
