Hey Quilty Friends! Lots to talk about this month so please read it all.

(1) Fat Quarter Exchange....if you brought black/white prints please pick up your shuffled fat quarters. If you plan to participate in the exchange this month, please bring 6 fat quarters in GRAY(S). Be sure to include your name & phone with your fat quarters.

(2) Block Raffle....we will have 2 separate draws this month. One for the 12.5" red/white/blue Farm Friendliness block from July & one for the 6.5" black/teal/white Darting Birds block from September.

(3) BOM....we will be showing 3 blocks! The 12.5x24.5" Flower block from June. This block utilizes APPLIQUE plus some sort of EMBELLISHMENTS. THE 12 5" square block from July which is TRAPUNTO plus CRAYONS. The 3rd block is the 18.5" square HOME block which reflects your personal take on the word "home".

I will also be showing the September block. Whew!!

(4) If you have a COMPLETED Stash Buster quilt, using Bonnie Hunter's Scrappy Mountain Majesties pattern, and/or a COMPLETED Scrap Buster quilt, using either Hourglass blocks or Log Cabin blocks, please be sure to show them and get your name in a ticket for the BIG drawing in November.

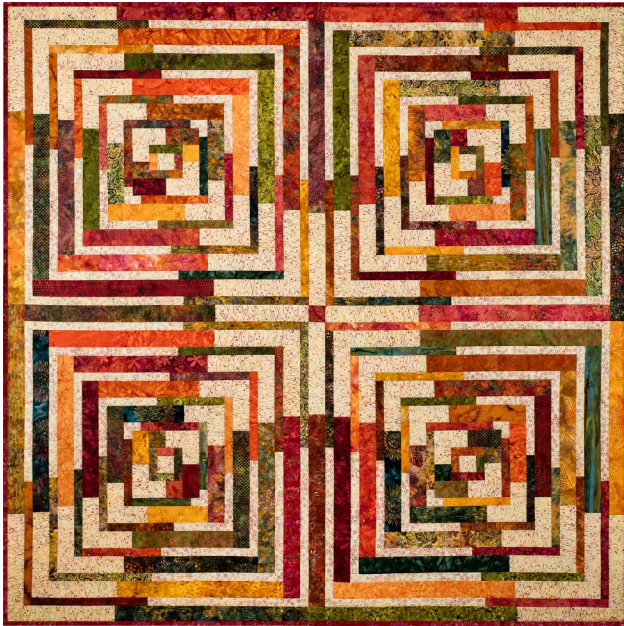

ANTELOPE CANYON SEW-IN

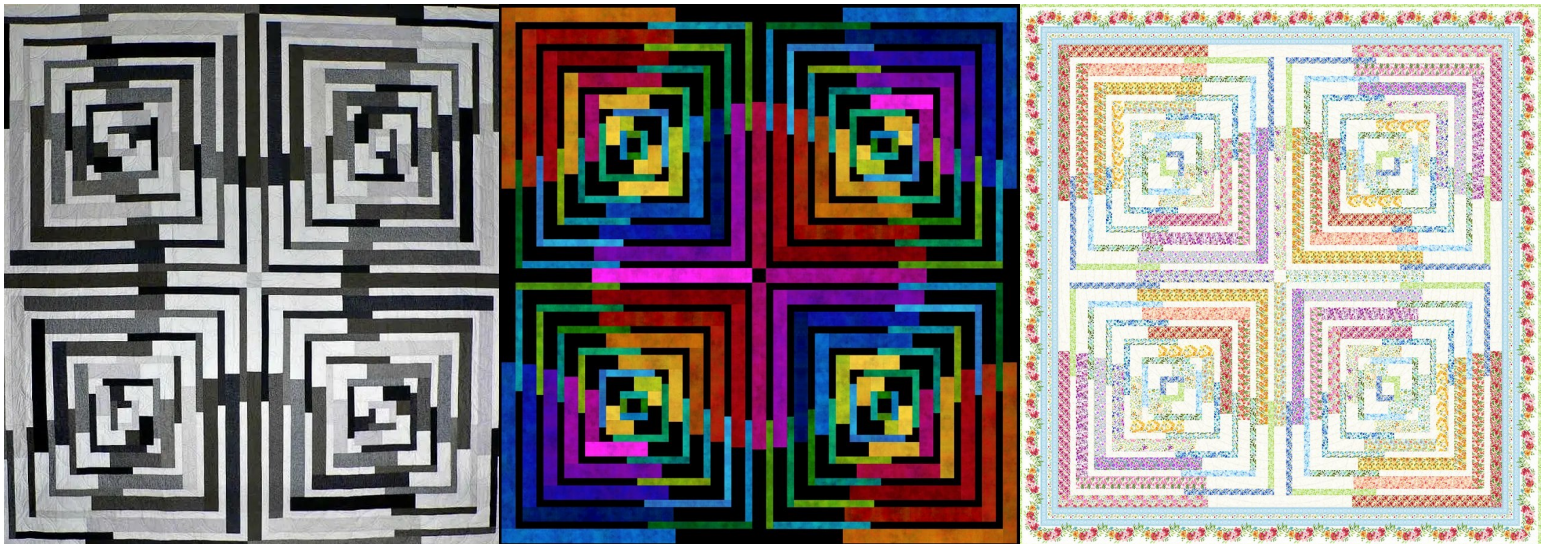

Lunch will be provided with the cost of the class (\$15). You will need to order the pattern which can be found on Etsy. In the meantime the fabric requirements and inspiration are below so you can pick out your fabrics now! Here is a link to an Etsy shop with the pattern.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS: 40" wide 100% cotton fabric	
Multi-colored fabrics Choose pre-cut strips such as Bali-Pops or jelly rolls (do not prewash), or cut strips from yardage (with the option of pre-washing)	Pre-cut Strips one set of forty 2½" x 40" strips and one set of forty 1½" x 40" strips —or— two sets of forty 2½" x 40" strips; you'll trim the second set to 1½" x 40"
Background fabric Choose different fabrics for the narrow and wide background strips, or use the same fabric for all background areas	Yardage ¼ yard each of 40 fabrics —or— smaller yardage pieces with at least 4" x 40" of usable fabric prior to cutting
	OR
	One Background fabric 2¾ yards OR Two Background fabrics 1½ yards for the 2½" strips and 1½ yards for the 1½" strips
Binding	¾ yard
Backing	4⅞ yards
Batting	80" x 80"
