Be sure to pick up your final shuffled fat quarters from the September exchange.

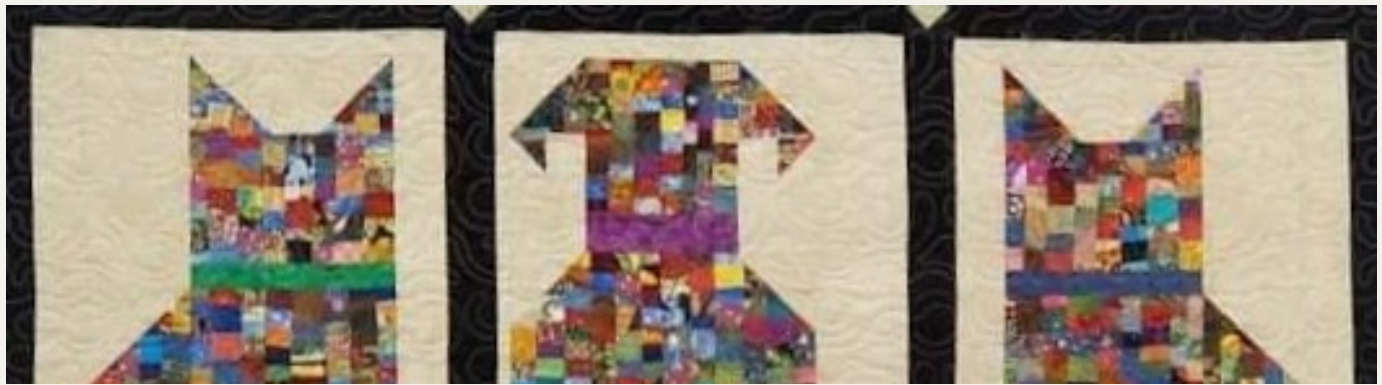
If you participated in the UFO exchange, bring the completed UFO to share.
