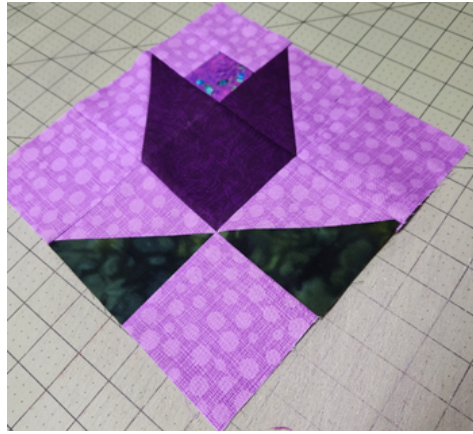

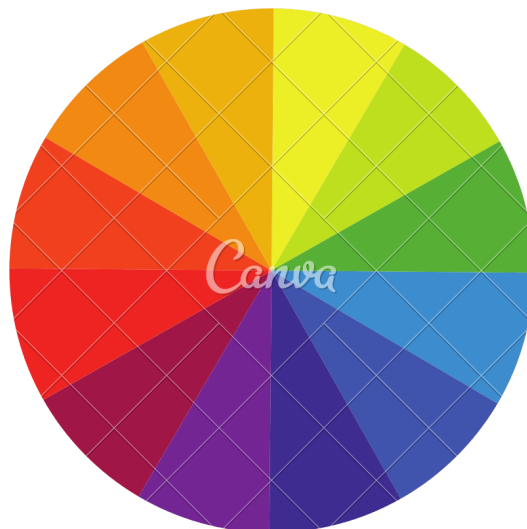


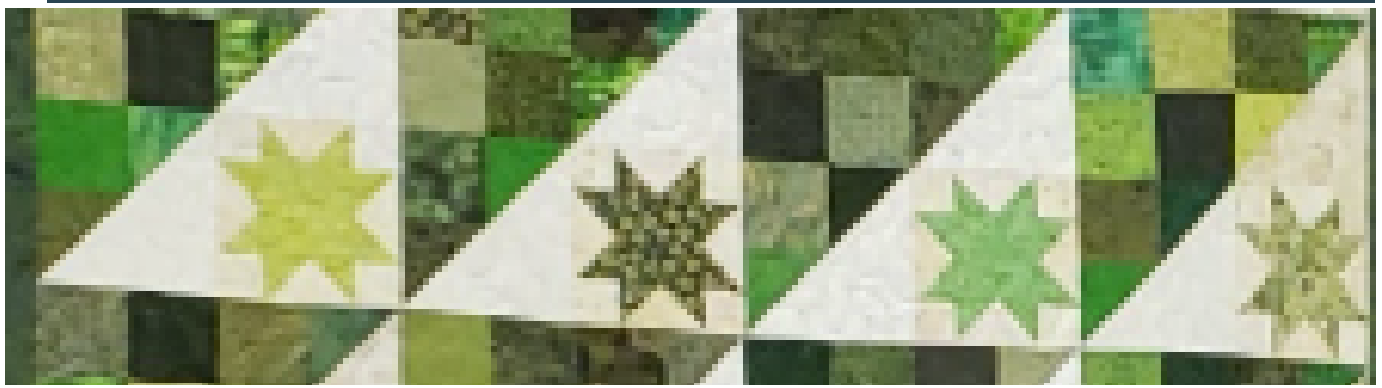
Do you ever have trouble deciding on color schemes for your quilts?
