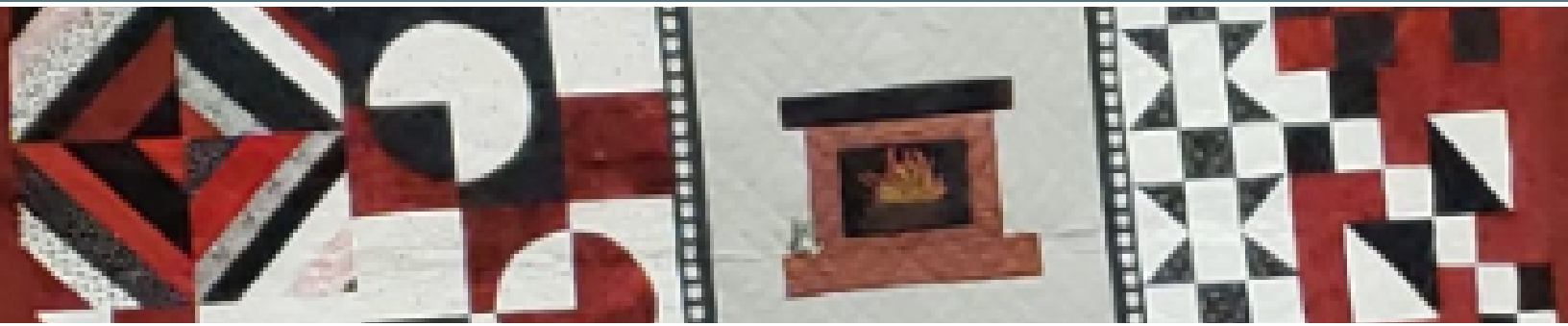


LIBRARY

Thanks to Zack Stoddard and his staff for providing QHM with this exhibit space. They are welcoming and great to work with!

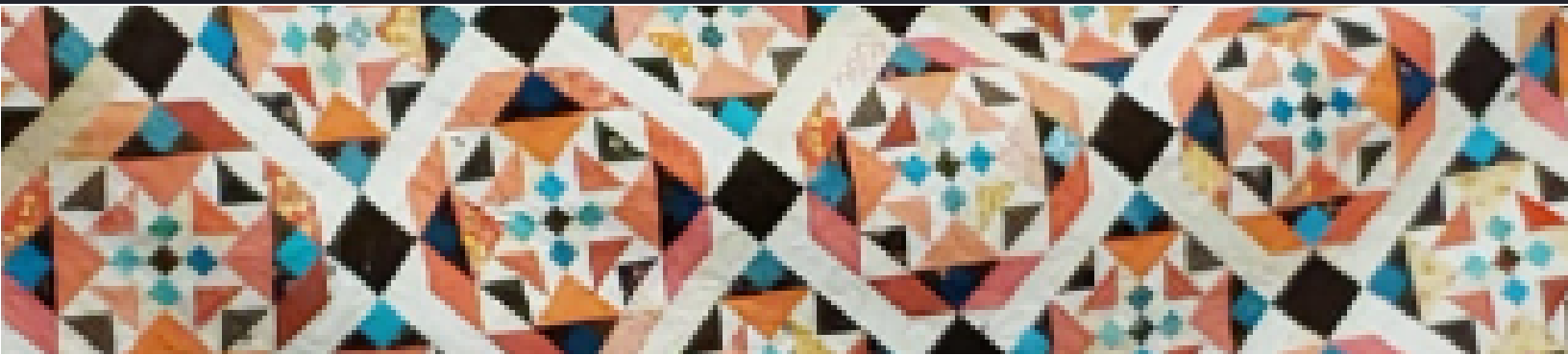


Handi Quilter Sweet Sixteen quilting machine. Sit down model.

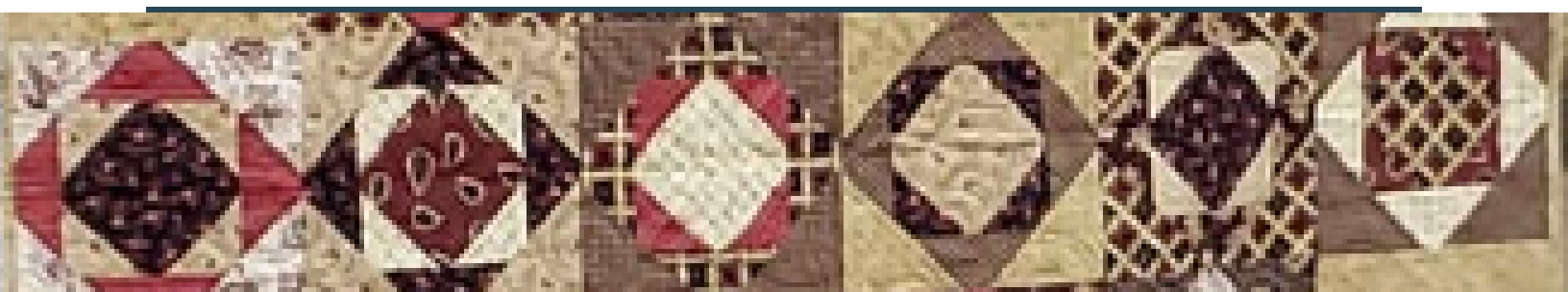

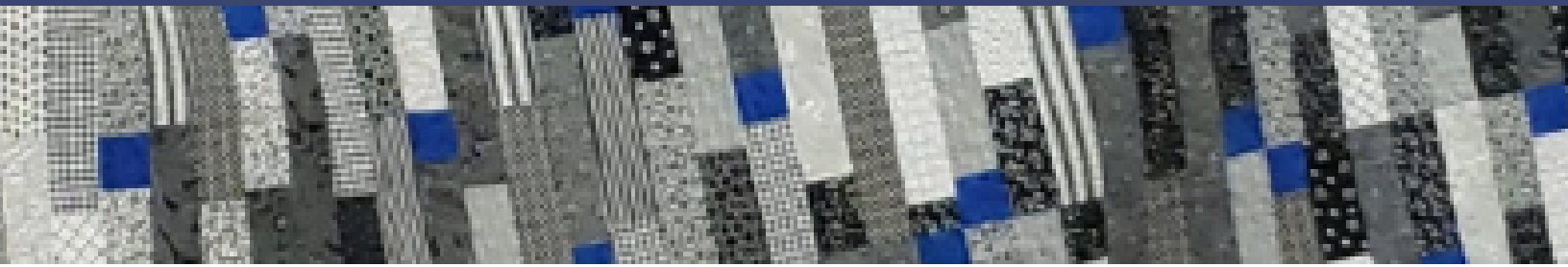

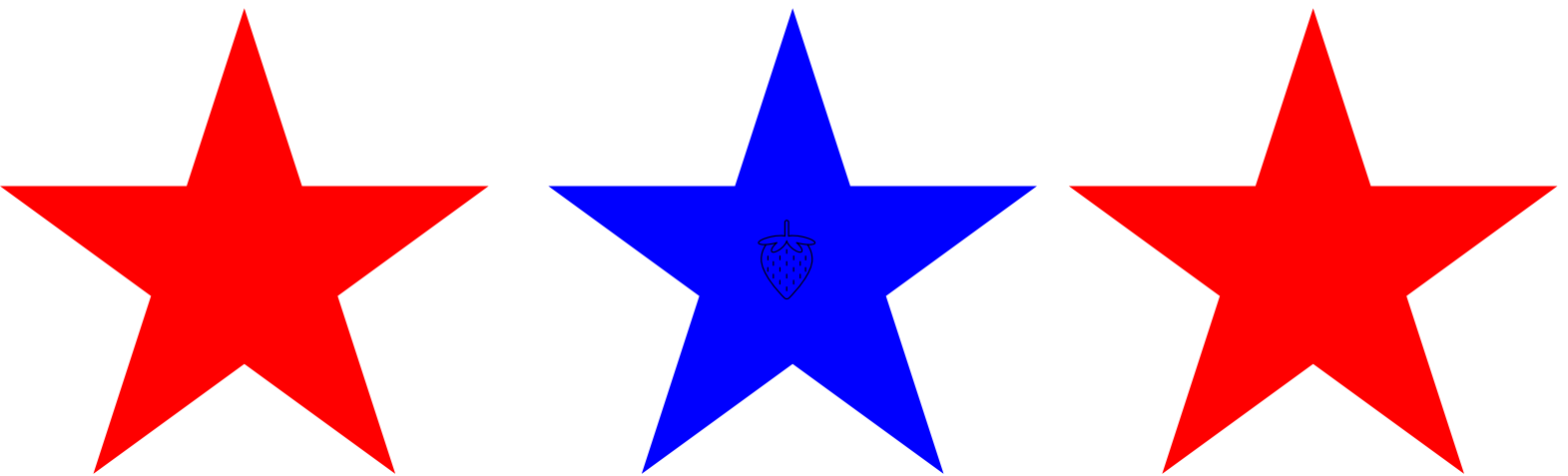
