July Row Quilt Instructions

Row Quilt – Flying Geese 3" x 6" Finished Units

Designed by Abigail Dolinger

The queen size row quilt requires 48 Flying Geese, arranged in two rows of 24 Geese each. Admittedly, this is a grand gaggle of geese,

Pairs of Geese of the same fabric are sewn together in the sample quilt. Experiment with color placement before deciding on your final arrangement. Sew the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Flying Geese together being careful not to stretch the two rows longer than 72 ½."

The **twin size** row quilt requires 16 Flying Geese, for one row. Sew the 3 %" x 6 %" Geese together being careful not to stretch the row longer than 48 %."

The **throw size** row quilt requires 16 Flying Geese. Sew pairs of Geese of the same fabric together and alternate them with Maple Leaves in Column 1 and Plus Signs in Column 5. The columns measure 6 ½" x 48 ½."



Cutting – this method makes 4 identical Geese Cut (1) 7 ½" colored square for Geese Cut (4) 3 7/8" background squares for "sky"

Sewing

Place 3 7/8" background squares in opposite corners of the 7 1/4" colored square, right sides together.

The corners of the background squares will overlap in the center. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line and press background triangles away from the colored triangle.



Place another 3 7/8" background square in the 90 degree corner and sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line and press background triangles away from the colored triangle. All 4 units should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½."



Do you need clarification for this construction method?

Observe the method but use the measurements given above for 3" x 6" (finished) Geese.
