Call to Order:

Guild president, Marei Montalvo, called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Notes from the President:

- The Fat Quarter Basket was sent around for people visiting, new members and those with June birthdays to take one.
- Challenge quilts drawing \$75 after break.
- Jack Edson 2 day workshop July 2025 max 15 students. \$125. List is on the sign in table. People can sign up as alternates.
- Elections will be held in September and since the Guild is a 501 (c) 3 charitable organization, a Board is required consisting of 4 elected positions: President; Vice-President; Treasurer; and Secretary. Without these, there can be no guild. The Community Chairs serve at the discretion of the President and are appointed. No one on the Current Board is running next year. A sign up sheet is on the sign in table.
 - President opens the building and runs the meetings
 - Vice-President sets up Education the months we meet in the Church. Not August, October or December.
 - Treasurer tracks money in and out and handles the money.
 - Secretary types up the minutes for Board and General meetings. They do not have to be verbatim.

Names Tag Drawing: Debbie Hamrick won the NameTag drawing. All the tickets go back in the bucket for a Big Drawing in November.

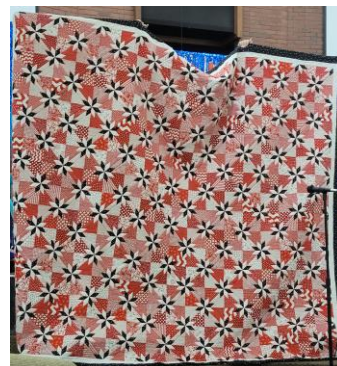
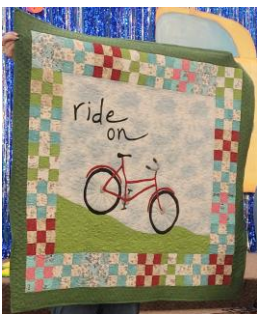

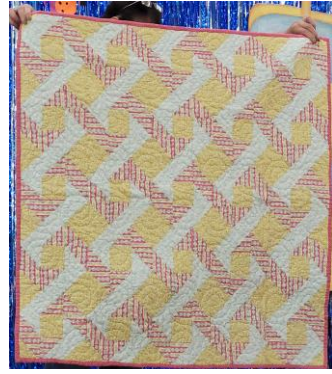
Marei's 6 pack challenge Susan Collins won a \$75 gift certificate to a local shop between Teton and Pocatello.
