Approve Minutes: A motion was made Marei to approve March 4th, 2025, Board minutes, Celia seconded, and the Board passed them.

Vice President report:

Treasurer Report:

Jr passed out budget sheet. Venmo can be done but she needs to be able to access the guild treasurer’s email. Christy needs to contact Crystal at the guild’s bank to finish being added to account.

Raffle was discussed regarding what the budget is vs what is being brought in and what it pays for. Rent is paid and the rest goes back into general funds. Raffle is set up as a rotating stock fund.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Community Support:

Trudy has 4 quilts out for quilting, has 9 quilts ready with tops and backs to be checked out. She must sew 8 backs for additional quilts. Thirty burp cloths were checked out and she has received 20 back. One quilt to be given to the "Village". It is a quilt for the organization to raise funds.

Equipment:

Christy got stuff out of the unit for Stash for Cash. She used Susan's sign out sheet so that it is known what goes in and out of storage unit. Susan found past rosters and she and Jody will need to go through them to come up with a list for the pins.

Historian:

Melinda asked how much of the meetings should be shown on Facebook? Show and tell is good and maybe the examples of upcoming raffle blocks or mystery quilt.

Intraguild:

Not much to report, determined that clue for mystery quilt may or not happen during stash for cash meeting.

Newsletter:

Submissions due April 12th. Marei asked if she could submit info for the day retreat in the newsletter.

Retreats:

Day retreat is April 12th at the Skyline Activity Center. Drive up to the double doors in back, unload cars then move car for someone else to unload. CAN NOT USE KITCHEN AT ALL. If used the culprit will pay the fee themselves.

October retreat already has 9 people signed up. School of Ministry building fills up fast so get your money in quickly. The retreat can hold 28 people. One hundred dollar non-refundable deposit is required after June 19th. Make out check to Snake River Valley Quilt Guild and date them October 1st so that it will be part of next fiscal year's budget.

Secret Quilter:

Tami said she may need to take a moment at the next Guild meeting to remind everyone that a gift is not required every single month. 4 to 5 a year is all that is required. Does not mean you *can't* do more just that you should only expect 4 to five. She will put it in the newsletter as well.

Sew Ins:

The last class went well with Kim Jockusch. She did a really good job. Eight people signed up for the Vest sew in this month. Still considering making the quilted jackets later this year as Christy bought the patterns from Daydreams due to a miscommunication. May sew in might be a duffle bag class but not for sure. Pam is going to put a request in the newsletter for class suggestions.

Webmaster:

David got more information for the lists on the site. Working on the lists for other quilt guilds.

Other business:

Christy asked to change the date of the next board meeting in May as she will be out of town. Marei made a motion to cancel the May board meeting. JR seconded and the board passed it.

Trudy asked if it might be possible to ask one of the people in charge of the organizations we are donating to come speak at a meeting. It would be nice to hear about what the quilts we donate are doing for the community. The board agreed.
