Sew Ins:

June is the Doable Duffle bag. The next sew in will be October, on the third Saturday. It will be a quilted coat. Patterns will need to be purchased from the guild as they have already been purchased by the guild.

Maralyn Bee, Tony Larson, and Linda Borba were all nominated for some sunshine.

Webmaster:

Lists of stores and repair shops have all been completed, unless new ones are suggested.

Other business:
